RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All competitors must pay Gate admission fees.
2. All exhibits are to be in the hands of the Secretary by 3pm, Wednesday, June 19th 2019.
3. Work recognized as being previously shown at Kalbar Show will be classed as non-competitive
4. Return freight or postage must be forwarded with entry fees where exhibits are required to be returned.
5. Crochet Cotton Requirements:
 - Fine Crochet Cotton No 60 up to No 150
 - Heavy Crochet Cotton No 40 down to Cotton No 10.
6. All exhibits must have securely attached the exhibitors name and class in which they are entered.
7. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor only, except as stated in Patchwork. Work must be unmarked and clean.
8. If the Judge considers any exhibit to be of insufficient merit, no award will be made.
9. Stewards and Judges reserve their right to change any entry into another class if necessary.
10. **PATCHWORK**, please attach description of quilts, EG: whether professionally quilted, own design or other....
11. Entries other than Textiles are to be entered in craft section
12. Judging to commence On Friday, June 21, 2019.
13. **Exhibitor Points Calculation:**
 - Any First Place - 3 points,
 - Any Second Place - 2 points
 - Any Third Place - 1 point.
 - Any Champion - 3 points.
14. Prize Money can be collected from the Treasurer's Office after 3pm Saturday **22nd June 2019**
15. The Society will not accept any liability for items exhibits, the risk being that of the exhibitor.
16. Electrical Equipment – Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical and or gas bottles to the showground's will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor or gas fitter. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and general public and is a requirement of work place health and safety act of 1995. The act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed on the Kalbar Showground's. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and all gas bottles to avoid occurrences of any difficulties.
