1. All exhibits are to be in the hands of the Chief Steward by 3pm, Wednesday, June 18th June 2025.
2. Work recognised as being previously shown at Kalbar Show will be classed as non-competitive.
3. Return freight or postage must be forwarded with entry fees where exhibits are required to be returned.
4. Crochet Cotton Requirements:
 - Fine Crochet Cotton No 60 up to No 150.
 - Heavy Crochet Cotton No 40 down to Cotton No 10.
5. All exhibits must have securely attached the exhibitors' name and class in which they are entered.
6. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor only, except as stated in Patchwork. Work must be unmarked and clean.
7. If the Judge considers any exhibit to be of insufficient merit, no award will be made.
8. Stewards and Judges reserve their right to change any entry into another class if necessary.
9. **PATCHWORK**, please attach description of quilts, EG: whether professionally quilted, own design or other....
10. Entries other than Textiles are to be entered in craft section.
11. **Exhibitor Points Calculation:**
 - Any First Place - 3 points,
 - Any Second Place - 2 points
 - Any Third Place - 1 point.
 - Any Champion - 3 points.
12. Prizemoney can be collected from the Secretary's Office after 3pm Saturday **21st June 2025**.
13. The Kalbar Show Society will not accept any liability for items exhibits, the risk being that of the exhibitor.
